ACCEPTED BY THE COMMITTEE, July 19th 1913

MANAGEMENT OF THE KING'S LYNN SOCIETY OF ARTS AND SCIENCES

- 1) The Society is instituted for the purpose of Science, Literature and the Fine Arts exclusively
- 2) The Society shall be open to persons of both sexes
- 3) There shall be a President and Vice-President to be elected at the AGM, and the affairs of the Society shall be arranged by an executive committee consisting of a Secretary and a Treasurer and thirteen other members all of whom shall be elected at the AGM. A Chairman and Vice-Chairman shall be elected by the Committee from amongst its members at its first meeting after the AGM. Five members shall form a quorum of the Committee, and all its Officers shall be honorary. Vacancies occurring during the year shall be filled by the Committee
- 4) For the better working of the Society and in order that the interest of all members may be considered, it shall be sub-divided into sections. Each section shall nominate its organising Secretary who shall be a member of the executive committee
- 5) The subscription of the Society shall be 7/6d. per annum, and 5/- for any member of a family after the first subscription, to be payable in advance and entitles membership from October 1st to September 30th.
- 6) No dividend, gift, division or bonus in money shall be made to or between any of the members.
- 7) Nomination for membership of the Society shall be sent to the Secretary, in writing, and be submitted to the Executive Committee at their next meeting
- 8) Any member wishing to resign shall give notice in writing to the Secretary at least seven days before the AGM
- 9) No amendment or alteration of these rules shall be made except at a General Meeting
- 10) The AGM of the Society shall be held in October but a special meeting may be called at any time by the Committee or on a requisition signed by at least ten members of the Society. The notice calling any special meeting shall, as far as practicable, state the purpose for which such a meeting is called

- 11) Any member may introduce to the Society's premises, a visitor who shall sign a Visitor's Book, but no person resident in the Borough may be introduced more than once a year except by special invitation of the Committee
 - 12) Non members may be allowed to join the excursions if introduced by a member and on payment of a fee to be fixed by the Committee

Rule 9 was placed as No. 12, the other numbers being altered accordingly and after the word "meeting" was added the words "notice of which shall be given at least seven days before the date of the meeting".
